Andrew Kenler, M.D., FACS is a board-certified general surgeon specializing in the treatment of benign and malignant breast disease. He received his bachelor's degree from Tufts University where he was Phi Beta Kappa and graduated Magna Cum Laude. He received his medical degree from Cornell University Medical College and completed his surgical training at the prestigious New England Deaconess Hospital, part of the Harvard Surgical Service.

Dr. Kenler is an active member of the ASBS and has been a clinical thought leader in the treatment of benign and malignant breast tumors using ultrasound-guided cryoablation. He is currently the Medical Director of Ice Cure Medical Ltd., an Israeli-based technology company specializing in the manufacture of cryoablation towers and probes. Dr. Kenler is the clinical trial primary investigator at Bridgeport Hospital, one of approximately 10 centers in the US participating in the ACOSOG Z1072 trial investigating cyroablation of small breast cancers.

As a clinical instructor of surgery at Yale Medical School, Dr Kenler is active in teaching surgical residents in and out of the OR.

Course Description

This intense one day program is designed to give physicians a detailed overview of the use of ultrasound technology, introduce the technique of ultrasound guided breast biopsy and prepare the physician to work with a registered diagnostic medical sonographer to safely and effectively perform ultrasound-guided breast biopsy procedures.

The morning session will introduce the basic principles of ultrasound, sonographically visualized breast anatomy, biopsy indication and patient selection criteria and minimally invasive biopsy technique. The afternoon session will offer hands-on experience for the physician to perform and practice biopsy techniques on inanimate phantoms working alongside a registered diagnostic medical sonographer.

We believe this program will provide each attending physician with an excellent introduction and a working overview of imaging the breast with medical ultrasound and the use of this technology for minimally invasive breast biopsy procedures. By the end of this program, the participant should be able to:

- Discuss the basic principles of breast ultrasound and image-guided breast biopsy technique
- Describe sonographic breast anatomy
- Describe and understand minimally invasive breast biopsy technique.

A certificate of completion will be awarded each participant upon successful communication of the principles noted above and demonstration of safe and effective ultrasound-guided biopsy technique.
